Math/Physics End-of-Year Poster Project

Summary

For this extra credit project, choose a concept or topic you learned about this year and make a poster which demonstrates or represents this topic creatively. You can choose to make this poster informational (intended to inform or help reinforce the subject) or artistic (intended to represent the topic in an unconventional or thought-provoking way) in nature. If desired, students can work in pairs; however no more than two can turn in a single poster.

Topic

You can select as a topic any subject or concept learned during this school year, whether Physics, Pre-Calculus or Calculus.

Requirements

Your poster must be completed on a full-sized poster board, not printer or copy paper and *definitely* not on standard lined paper. It must be colored, and must represent the subject or topic accurately. It does not necessarily have to be hand-drawn (collage-style is okay), so long as the overall theme of the poster is clear.

Grading

Your poster will be graded and receive up to 50 points based on the following criteria: **Content, Presentation, Clarity and Neatness, Accuracy,** and **Understanding of Concept**. In addition, if your poster scores more than 30 out of 50 points, it can be used to exempt one assessment grade for the 4th nine weeks.
